- Blue tie with double stripes and academy logo

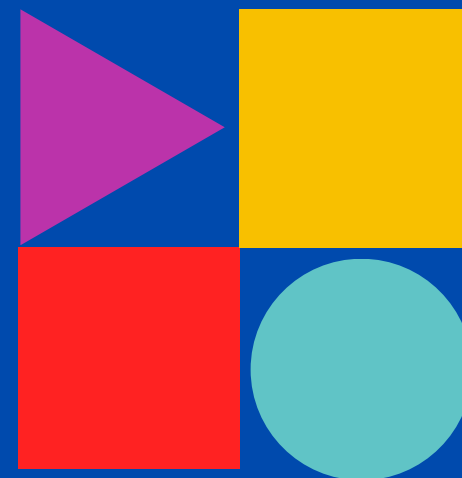
Note
